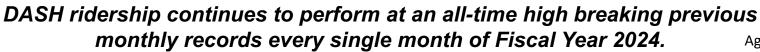

CITY MANAGER'S PROPOSED BUDGET (FY2025)

Employee Focus: Addresses employee compensation and collective bargaining

agreements.

Schools Funded: Provides increased funding for Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS).

Strategic Investments: Advances City priorities like affordable housing and economic

development.

\$911.3 Million Budget: Maintains current tax rates and services.

Employee Benefits: Step increases and 2% pay raises for eligible city staff.

Community Focus: Invests in initiatives to strengthen connections and address disparities.

Key takeaway: The FY 2025 budget prioritizes employees, schools, and key city

initiatives without raising taxes.



DASH IMPACTS - PROPOSED BUDGET (FY2025)

General Fund amount for DASH increases by \$4.6 million (16.6%)

- Costs of New Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA).
- Fare-free service grant (TRIP) expires, increasing subsidy.

Reductions Totaling (\$380,540)

- Line 104 reduction from 30 min peak frequency to 60 min peak frequency.
 (\$180,000)
- Administrative Reductions (\$200,540)

Unfunded Supplementals

 The proposed budget does not include funding of any DASH supplementals, most notably the Local Grant Match requirements for DASH grants totaling \$54,000



DASH SUPPLEMENTALS AS SUBMITTED

Prioritized Supplementals:

- 1. Grant Local Match \$54,000
- 2. Line 32 Service Enhancement \$850,000
- 3. Line 34 Service Enhancement \$150,000
- 4. Line 31 Service Enhancement \$1,100,000

Contractually Required Supplemental:

1.5% additional wage increase (in addition to existing 4%) - \$340,000



RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

Consider public testimony and written communications emphasizing:

- Thanks to the City Manager and Council for prioritizing funding the core services (current services) requirements for DASH
- Reductions to DASH services (Line 104) are contrary to the priorities established by Council and the ATC Board, they erode the progress of the New DASH Network
- Failing to fund Local Grant Match is contrary to the priorities set by Council
 - It puts the reputation of DASH as a reliable recipient of State Transportation Grant Funding at risk
 - The DASH Board and City Council adopted resolutions endorsing these grant applications

ATC is projecting a lowered year-end deficit of (~\$4,097)

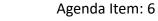
Notable Items:

- Operations Overtime reduced significantly following an internal reorganization, implementation of a new attendance policy, and stringent cost control policies.
- Maintenance Parts and Supplies decreased due to strategic changes in purchasing processes, timing, and suppliers.
- The General Manager implemented a sweeping discretionary spending freeze on December 1, 2023 which remains in effect.



PLANNING DEPARTMENT CUSTOMER SURVEY SUMMARY





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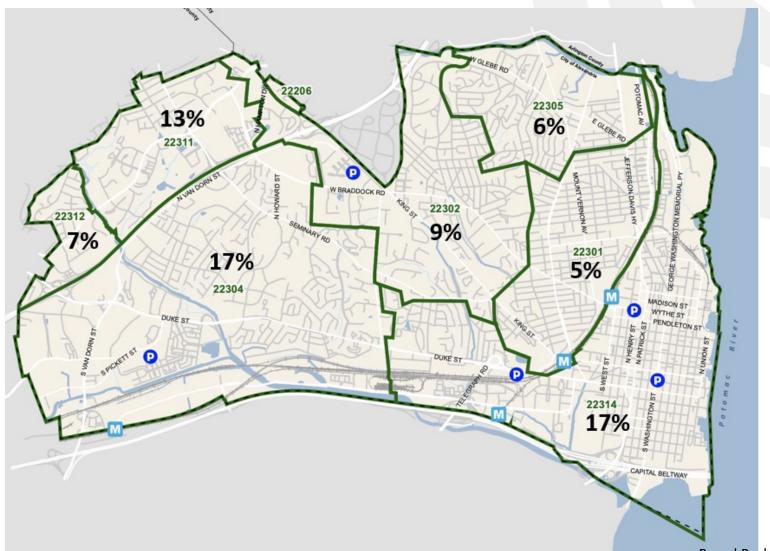
DASH ONBOARD RIDER SURVEY

- 2,983 valid survey responses.





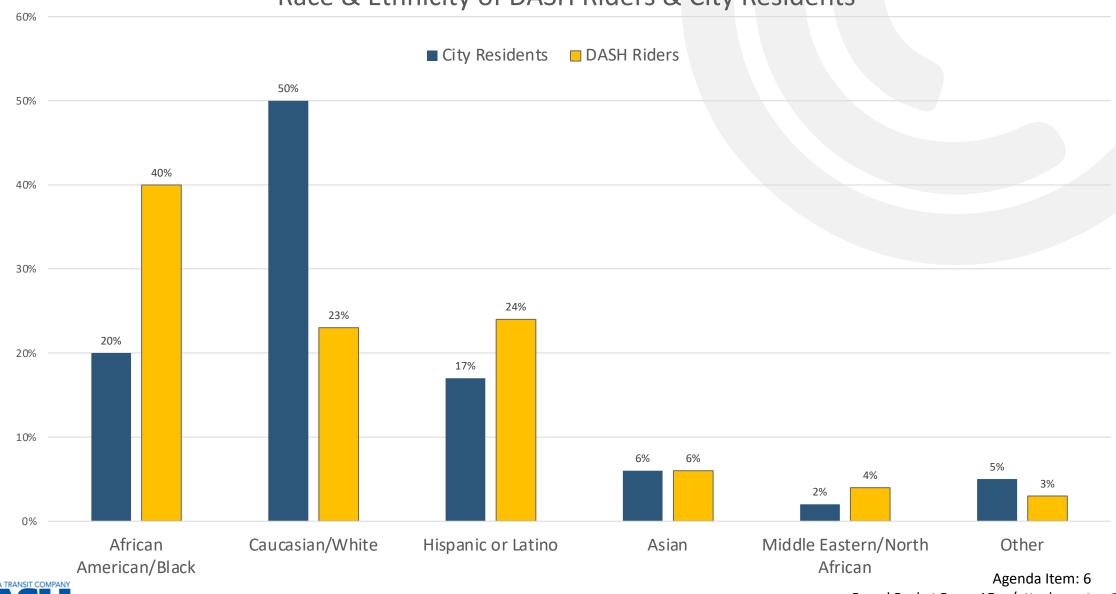
SURVEY RESPONSES BY HOME ZIP CODE





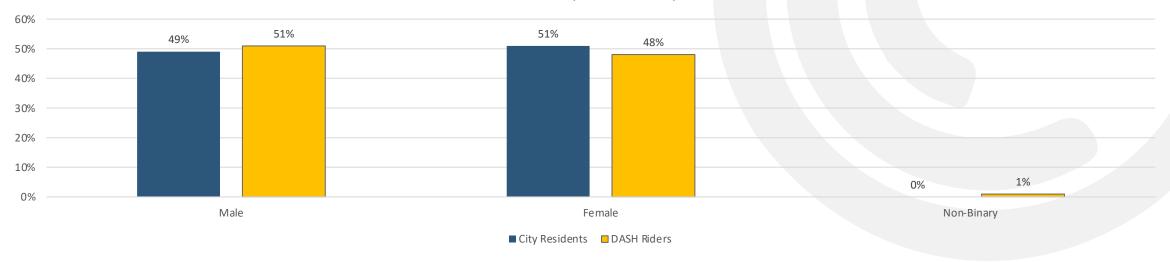

Race & Ethnicity of DASH Riders & City Residents

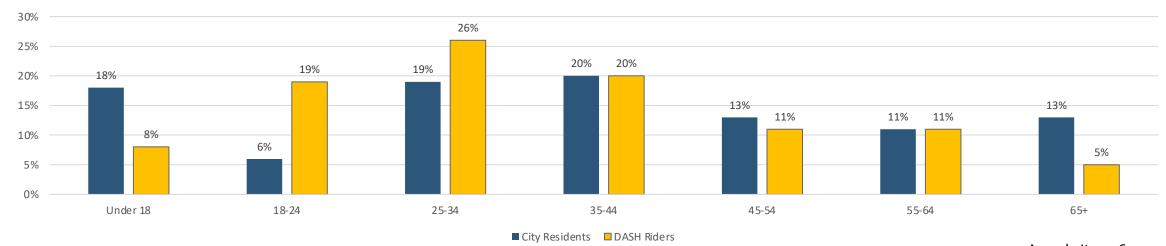


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DASH Riders & City Residents by Gender



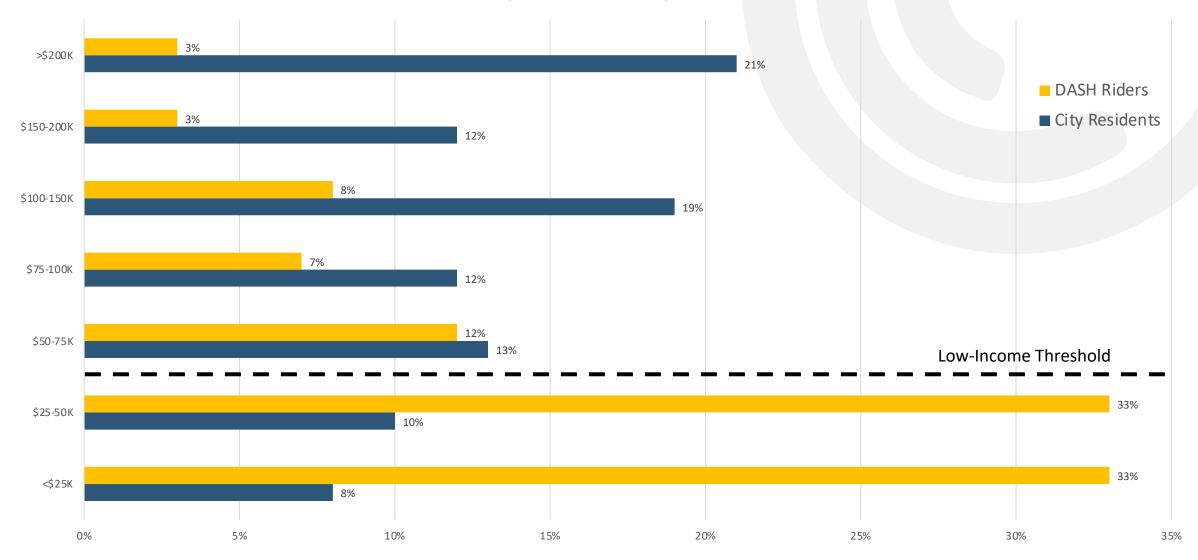
DASH Riders and City Residents by Age (Years)

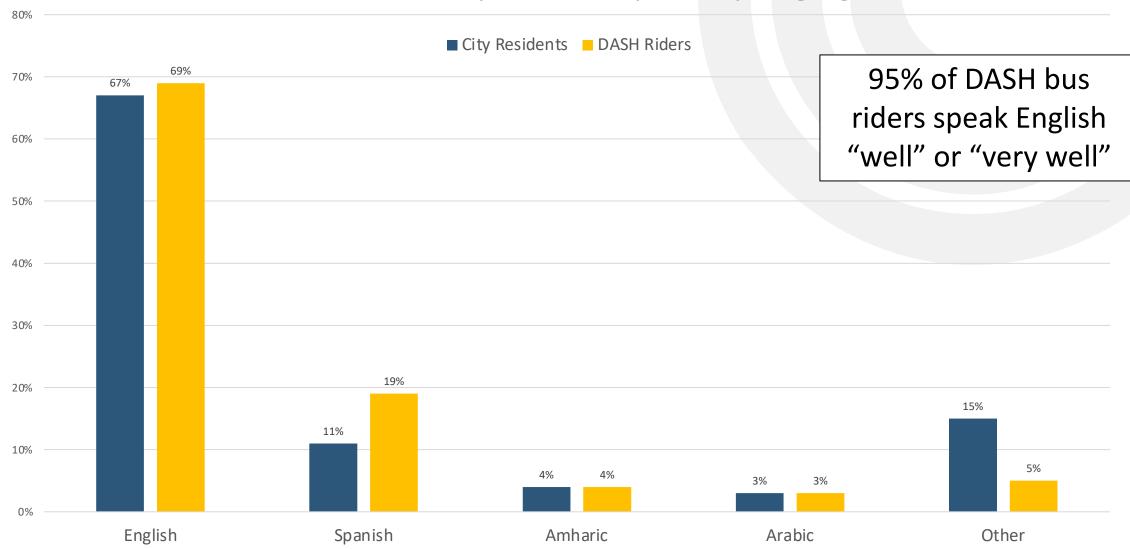
DASH Riders & City Residents by Household Incomes





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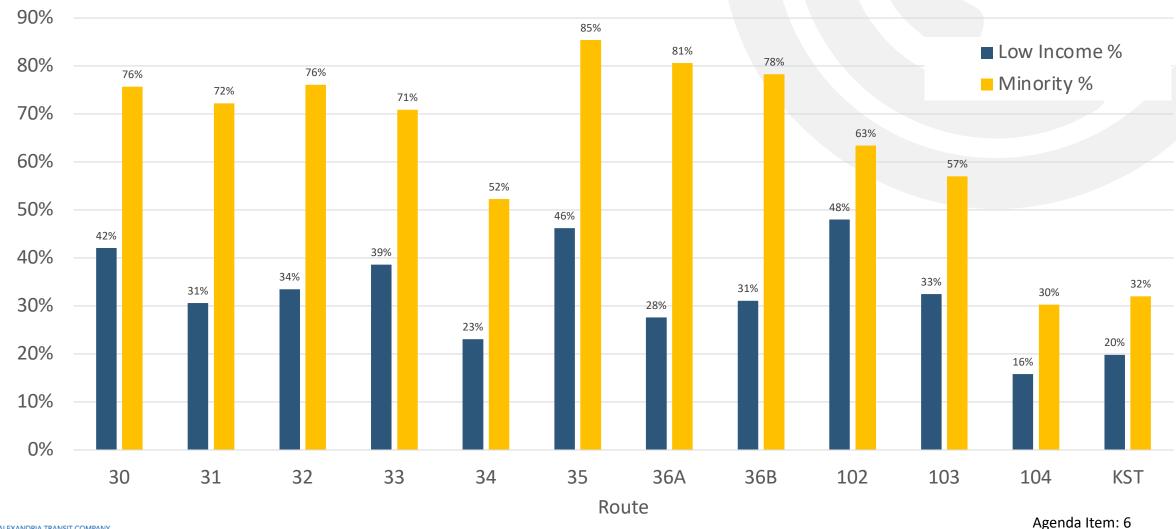
DASH Riders & City Residents by Primary Language

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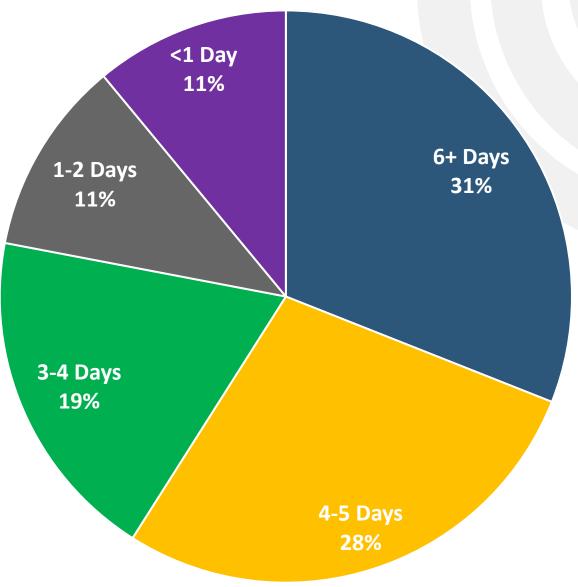
RACE & ETHNICITY RESPONSES BY DASH ROUTE (TITLE VI)





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Number of Days Using DASH Per Week

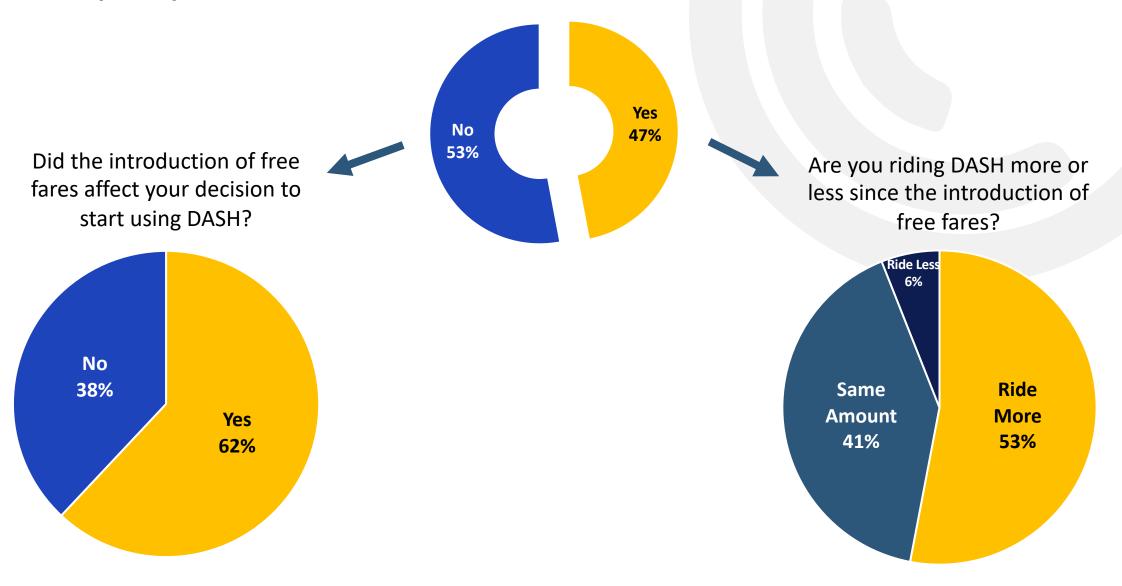

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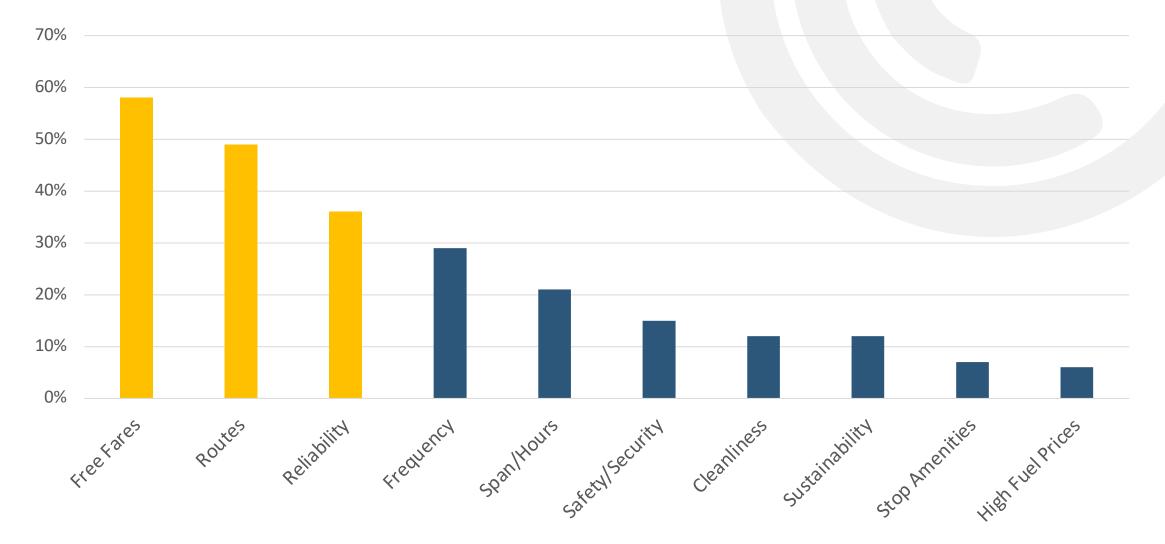
Q16 | Did you ride DASH before introduction of free fares and New Network?

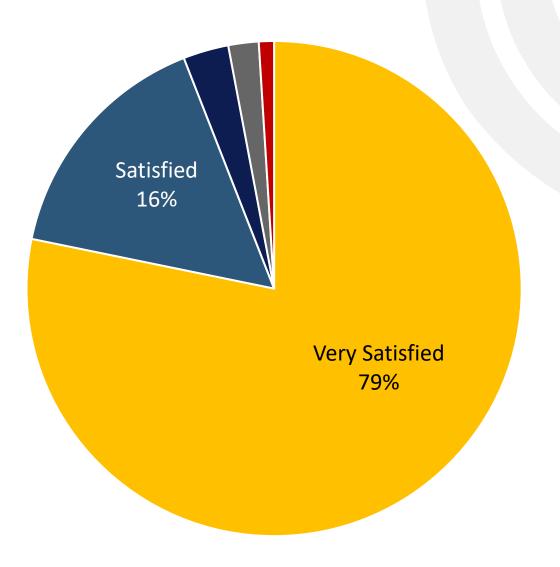
MOST IMPORTANT FACTORS IN RIDING DASH (CHOOSE UP TO 3)
