Item #3 – Outside Auditor

Consideration of Approval:

By agreement with the City of Alexandria, ATC accounts are maintained by the City's Department of Finance and are audited as a part of the City's annual audit. If the City's outside auditor is also ATC's outside auditor, the ATC audit can be done without duplication of effort or cost.

It is therefore recommended that the City's outside auditor be designated ATC's outside auditor.

5.7 million riders in 2025, breaking DASH's all-time records for the third year in a row

Fiscal Benefits



Every dollar invested in DASH supports an additional \$1.60 in statewide revenues – a 160% return on investment¹

Environmental Stewardship



3.8 million SOV trips displaced
16,000 tons of CO2 emissions eliminated

Equity Impacts



3.7 million low-income passengers
4.2 million annual minority passenger trips
2 million trips from zero-car households

Bus Stop Improvements Completed in FY25

Transit Amenities

- 6 Solar powered lights added

Bus Stop Accessibility

- 24 Total ADA improvements
 - 9 Locations with parking removed
 - 15 ADA pads added

Landmark Transit Center

- Relocated to permanent home at West Alexandria Transit Center
- Additional phases coming soon

King Street Corridor Bus Stop Consolidation

- Consolidated bus stops along corridor
- Consistent stop spacing between KSM and City Hall
- KST and OTC now all stop at the same stops in this corridor
- Installed u-channel style post, more consistent for ADA, visually impaired.





Future Bus Stop Improvements

Bus Stop Accessibility

- 39 more ADA pads to be added

Transit Amenities

- Additional 20 Solar powered lights
- Additional Benches
- More stops with Real Time bus information

King Street Bus Improvement Plan

- Installation of Benches
- Pilot “lean rails”
- Reviewing possible curb extensions

DRPT TRIP Grant – Bus Stop Improvements

- Landmark / West Alexandria Transit Center
 - 12 Interim shelters anticipated FY26
 - Final transit center design anticipated to start FY26




Successes & Challenges

- DASH facility **cleared and operational by Monday morning**
- DASH **modified routes** to accommodate for conditions
- DASH **restored full service** before other regional operators
- **WMATA crews** supplemented City crews clearing **46 additional DASH stops**
- As of **February 4th**, **~20% of DASH bus stops** were clear and fully accessible
