

Eisenhower Avenue Corridor

The following list summarizes what the new bus network will look like for Eisenhower Avenue:

- **[Line 32](#)**. This new DASH route will replace the existing AT7 route with similar weekday service levels, however, unlike the AT7, Line 32 will operate with direct service to the King Street Metro on Saturdays and Sundays. Existing customers who use the AT7 to travel into Old Town on weekdays will need to transfer at King Street Metro to the Old Town Circulator ([Line 30/Line 31](#)) or the King Street Trolley.
- **[King Street Trolley](#)**. The King Street Trolley is scheduled to resume service in September with the launch of the New DASH Network. It will operate every 15 minutes, all day, from 11:00 AM to 11:00 PM, 365 days per year. The 2022 Alexandria Transit Vision Plan also recommended that the King Street Trolley should be extended from the King Street Metro to the Eisenhower Metro to connect the new high-density developments in Eisenhower East and Carlyle with Old Town. This extension will require the purchase of additional trolleys and is therefore not proposed until FY 2024. If the extension is implemented, Line 32 would be proposed for realignment from its current routing in Carlyle to operate along John Carlyle Street and Eisenhower Avenue.
